HOW DO YOU VIEW the world? Not the created earth but the people in the world. When you see the world what are your thoughts? Does it seem like an impossible task to reach them for Christ? What are the opportunities? What are the possibilities? Can you make an impact even if it seems small?

I HAVE BEEN THINKING about how God takes someone out of obscurity and creates a legacy of blessing in their lives. Our speaker at our Labour weekend camp, Graham Ashby, was plucked out of what would seem an impossible environment to become a major impacter of the gospel in our country. I have a Pastor friend who was a very “active” teenager (to put it nicely) but got saved and now leads a vibrant church in Tauranga seeing souls come to Christ. A key leader in our worldwide ministry of Word of Life recently shared how his father had witnessed a horrific scene in his home as a child but got saved and has left a lasting legacy of many family members who have been saved. His family continues that legacy of sharing their faith today. I have been reminded that every soul is an opportunity to make a difference for Christ. Never underestimate what Christ will do with a soul surrendered to Him.

AS WE HEAD TOWARD CHRISTMAS we remember something that seemed like a pretty insignificant event to the world. A virgin gave birth to a child in a stable. No one really knew who she was, but what appeared irrelevant to the world would change the course of history. This little child would bring redemption to the whole world (LUKE1:26-38). Did Mary and Joseph understand it all at this point? I am sure they didn't. However, they were obedient to do what God asked of them and their obedience impacted the world forever. *“For nothing will be impossible with God.”* Luke 1:37

ARE YOU ALLOWING the Holy Spirit to speak to you about a lost soul? I encourage you to start praying for one soul and trusting the Holy Spirit to bring them to faith in Christ. You will never know how this one step of obedience could make a radical change to your neighbourhood, your church, your city, your country or this world. Let the reminder of the impact Christ made on this world, no matter how insignificant His beginning seemed, spur you on to make an impact for the cause of Christ this coming year.




We have seen God at work this year within our team, throughout NZ, Fiji, Samoa and beyond!



I THANK GOD FOR HIS FAITHFULNESS to my family and me. He has taken care of our needs especially our children and provided the opportunity to attend the Pacific Rim Word of Life Conference. We were really encouraged by what the Lord is doing in other parts of the world and challenged by the theme “Together we serve.”

2016 HAS TAUGHT US TO TRUST God and His Sovereignty instead of our plans and timetable. We thought we had figured out how we were going to do ministry this year but God had other plans for us. Cyclone Winston, which happened in February, changed all that and opened doors in ways we couldn't have imagined possible in reaching out to the 9 villages on Charles' home island. Praise God for the churches and individuals He has touched to bless those in need who lost their homes and livelihood during this cyclone.

LOOKING AHEAD, we have the opportunity, upon the request of a pastor from the mainstream church, to help with their young people. This has resulted in a combined youth camp from 1-5 December 2016. “Youth” in the village setting is a little bit different, so the campers will range from early teens to mid-forties. Please pray that souls will be won for Christ and lives encouraged to live for Him. Pray that the sound system will work well so that the whole village can hear the message.

THE LORD HAS OPENED ANOTHER DOOR to serve as Youth Coordinators for the Brethren Churches in Fiji. This involves working alongside the Local Church Ministries around the country and we are excited and looking forward to serving, encouraging and being encouraged by the youth leaders

WE HAVE BEEN DISCIPLING eleven boys who currently sleep at the church. They started off with digging drains around the church, cutting the grass and helping out at other church families' homes and we now have them helping in ministry. Please pray for them and for those who have given their lives to God for His direction upon them and for the others who are still seeking.

PRAISE GOD for a chicken shed given to us which can house 3000 chickens. We are hoping to rebuild it to its former state, sell meat birds and use this to generate a source of income to support the workers and the ministry. Pray along with us that God will provide the financial help to get it up and running.

PLEASE PRAY FOR GOD TO SEND WORKERS to join us here in Fiji under the Word of Life banner whose passion is to evangelise and disciple young people for His kingdom. We value your prayers, encouragement and support.


